**SCHOOL NURSE NEWS:** Effective immediately and upon recommendation from our school physician and approval of our Board of Education, we are no longer offering strep tests in school. The regulations pertaining to

running a clinical laboratory in the school setting have become too time consuming and costly for us to continue. Please note that strep tests are readily available throughout the county and are performed at physician's offices, urgent clinics, and even retail pharmacy clinics. Students coming to the health office showing signs of strep throat will be referred to their health care provider for evaluation.

**5<sup>th</sup> GRADE NEWS:** Last Friday, Stillwater School's entire 5<sup>th</sup> grade made their annual trip to see the Liberty Science Center in Jersey City, NJ. LSC is a full hands-on,

interactive science center that allows children to become participants in the learning instead of just observing facts. Can you navigate a pitch-black maze using only your sense of touch? Students enjoyed many trips through the Touch Tunnel....minus light of course! Students were also able to enter a cityscape of towers and discover what it takes to design and build the world's tallest skyscrapers. Also, from the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor deck students were able to see the Liberty Tower in lower Manhattan with its just newly added spire. And of course, students were able to see Miss Liberty from the same deck at LSC. Stillwater students were able to experience the Opening Day of the Block Party Exhibit. This is where kids can create whimsical architecture, oceangoing vessels, space-bound rocket ships, futuristic cities, and fabulous forts using over 16,000 oversized blocks. They designed, created, knocked down, and started all over again in this engineering fun fest. Did you see the size of that NOSE on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor in Infection Connection? Just by passing in front of this huge physical nose display, students were 'sneezed on' by the exhibit. From here, students were able to see and feel (yes, there was a wet breeze that could saturate you if you weren't looking!) how microbes are passed from just one simple sneeze. Our IMAX presentation was not just on mere spelunking, it was on the Journey into Amazing Caves. We learned about the world's most remote, unexplored caves. Cavers searched for extreme living organisms in the ice caves of Greenland, the underwater caves of the Yucatan Peninsula, and the earth caves of the Little Grand Canyon. 4th graders, be ready for an equally exciting trip next year!!!
